Targeted Survey

Rationale:

- To obtain additional information regarding transition of EI eligible children
- To clarify 2004 data gathered by the Early Intervention Section
- To further the work of the 3-5 Workgroup

Methodology:

- Data will be collected from the DOE 619 Coordinators, the Transition Survey, Case Reviews and Phone Interviews with parents of children who had received services from EI and are currently over the age of 3.
- Data to collected will target the following groups:
